- A \$277-million Oklahoma City Convention Center.
- 605-room headquarters hotel operated by **Omni Hotel & Resorts**.
- The **Oklahoma City Streetcar**, **BRT Line and trails** connects all these amenities to the rest of downtown.

### **WHAT IS MAPS?**

Metropolitan Area Projects (MAPS) is Oklahoma City's pay-as-yougo, temporary-sales-tax, capital investment program. Downtown has attracted more than \$7 billion in public and private investment since the original MAPS projects.

MAPS I (1993) - \$363-million package, 9 projects including:

- Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark
- Bricktown Canal
- Oklahoma River
- Chesapeake Energy Arena

**MAPS for Kids (2001)** - \$700-million package that renovated or rebuilt every school in Oklahoma City limits.

### MAPS 3 (2009) - \$777-million package, 8 projects including:

- Modern Streetcar
- Whitewater rafting facility
- Convention center
- 70-acre Scissortail Park

MAPS 4 (2019) - \$1.1-billion package, 16 projects including:

- Investment in OKC's Innovation District
- Multipurpose outdoor stadium
- Beautification of key corridors
- 70% dedicated to neighborhood & human needs
